

# 727 Smith Ridge Road

Set beautifully upon a ridge in one of New Canaan's oldest estate areas, this magnificent New England shingle and stone home creates a grand impression. Through the gates and up a sweeping driveway, visitors are welcomed by a large, inviting porch. Stepping into the spacious front-to-back foyer, there is much to take in. Start with the flooring of a boxed herringbone pattern with black walnut inlay. Next, enjoy the creatively displayed collection of antique weather vanes that graces one wall. The grand staircase, which cascades down in three directions, is the backdrop for its own intriguing collection of antique sleds. From here, oversized doorways provide views of the formal living room, library, and sunroom. The large formal dining room features a hand-painted mural, commissioned by the homeowners, which covers all four walls. The roomy butler's pantry is adjacent with custom alder cabinetry and arched seeded glass front doors. Azul de Mar granite countertops, oak flooring, and a spider web window over the weathered copper sink give formality to this functional room. The expansive country kitchen features classic white cabinetry



with backlit stained glass panels at the top. There are two large semi-circular islands, each boasting a deep sink and unique red lava stone counter. Bold and playful decorating decisions set the tone for this one-of-a-kind kitchen. Red and white gingham cloth covers the ceiling and walls while the floor is painted in a bold blue and white checkerboard pattern featuring whimsical renderings of fruit. Off the kitchen a colorful, custom rug is the foundation for a cozy family room with stone fireplace and coffered ceiling. This very American home is large enough to entertain crowds yet so personalized and comfortable for informal family gatherings.





#### 400 South Avenue

Reflecting the trend towards the convenience of in-town living, South Avenue has become a highly sought after address in New Canaan. This long, wide road leads right into the heart of town, and now boasts a fine array of beautiful, surprisingly expansive new homes. This particular home, a traditional New England style, sits back slightly from the road behind a stacked stone walled topped with classic picket fencing. Upon entering, the elegant foyer provides a classically formal yet engaging welcome. Travertine flooring flows through wide keystone arches, and leads effortlessly to the library, living room, main staircase, and formal dining room. The sizable and inviting kitchen is meant to accommodate day to day living as well as large family gatherings. The goal was to combine traditional styling with less formal features to create a comfortable, soothing environment. Custom-built beaded inset cabinetry is painted a classic soft white for a more traditional feel while details such as seeded glass, bin pulls and latches add charm. The expansive island topped with Calacatta marble provides plenty of seating, and is complimented by a raised custom-built buffet of knotty alder, which reinforces the less formal theme. The builtin desk with clear alder wood top is surrounded by generous shelving, and provides a convenient spot for homework, while a custom designed hutch becomes the focal point of the room. Painted in a slightly distressed blue green this unique piece with oversized exposed hinges, ring pulls, and cup pulls, also acts as a counter-balance to the more traditional features of the kitchen. Despite the relatively small footprint of the property, thoughtful design and careful planning resulted in this luxurious yet comfortable family home right in the heart of town.
